

East Pikeland Township - Open Space Committee

August 17, 2010

- 1. Meeting called to order at 7:05 by chairman Strauss**
- 2. Present : Stock Illoway, , John Schott, Marilyn Randolph, Dave Jarvie, Rusty Strauss**
Absent: Frank Giardina, George Irwin, Barbara Heck
- 3. Stock moved and John seconded the approval of the June minutes with the following corrections: Under 2 Present should read "Dave" Jarvie not "Dan" Jarvie. Also move statement from 3rd paragraph under #6 Additional discussion "Stock will talk with the Cutlers attorney" etc. under Follow up actions.**
- 4. Rusty gave an update of the current status of the Massaro and Latshaw properties. Both conservation easements are proceeding.**
- 5 Stock spoke to Mr. McBride, Cutler Attorney, regarding the Cutler properties in East Pikeland Township and whether or not they would be interested in putting a conservation easement on them. Mr. McBride's response was that he felt the company could "weather the storm" and he didn't think the property in East Pikeland was a good match. The OSC agreed and decided not to pursue further.**
- 6. Stock also called Marcus Kolb to get an update of their interest regarding and easement.**
- 7. Gus Meyer Properties in East Pikeland: There was a discussion about several of the properties that Gus Meyers owns in East Pikeland, specifically a 16-acre parcel that includes the Stony Run. The OSC felt that this would be good parcel to investigate.**

Rusty will send Dave Jarvie information about the specific parcels and Dave will contact Gus to see if he has any interest in selling to the township or an easement.

8. East Pikeland Township Properties: There was a discussion about putting conservation easements on property already owned by East Pikeland Township. A motion was made by John Schott and seconded by Dave Jarvie as follows:

“Have the OSC contact both Natural Lands Trust and The French and Pickering Creek Conservation Trust, give them an inventory of the East Pikeland properties, and ask them to make a presentation to the committee of how they would suggest to conserve the land.”

All were in favor, with one abstention (Stock Illoway).

9. Marilyn moved and Stock seconded the adjournment of the meeting at 8:20.
