



East Pikeland Historical Commission/HARB Meeting Minutes January 16, 2013

The meeting commenced at 7:00 pm. The meeting agenda was presented to the Commission members and the following issues were addressed:

GENERAL

- **Minutes** - The minutes from the December 19, 2012 meeting were presented and approved.
- **Historical Resource Survey** – Based on the Township feedback, Tom Scofield is currently adding descriptions to the property entries on the historic resource list. *Update: Ms. Moser spoke to Tom Scofield and reports that he is about 2/3 of the way through the inventory list. He will let the Commission know when he is finished. He is asking that a member meet with him to run through the list after he is finished as a last check and balance.*
- **Township 175th Anniversary** – Ms. Jommersbach updated the Commission with the plans proposed by the Township Anniversary Planning Committee.
- **Potential New Historic Commission Members** – Three residents of the township, Jamie DeFelice, Andy Gustine, and Molly Rezicka, attended the meeting and have expressed interest in joining the Commission.

HERITAGE PARK

- **American Battlefield Protection Program (ABPP) Grant** – Mr. Garrison reported that the ABPP has issued a 6-month extension to allow them additional time to review the report.

NEW BUSINESS

- **Jennifer McKay/ Purls of Wisdom Yarn & Fiber Shoppe - 2200 Kimberton Road –**
Ms. McKay came to the Commission to present layouts for her stores signage. The sign will be made of alupalite board and built on a frame that that will be braced off the roof. The background will be a cream color with navy blue graphics. After review the Commission agreed to issue a certificate of appropriateness for either a 1' x 5' sign or a 2' x 6' sign where the top part of the sign would be curved.

- **Wilson Farm Store - Kimberton Road –** Mr. Garrison reported that the owner met with State Senator Andrew Dinniman to discuss the building and the possibility of elevating the former Wilson Farm Store from a non-contributing to a contributing resource so it would be eligible to be a tax act rehabilitation. There has been no report from that meeting.
