Park and Recreation Board Meeting
February 21, 2013**

Park and Recreation Members Present: Jerry Miller, Caesar Muzzioli, Allen Koons, Mike Sisti, Sean McShane. Staff: Kim Moretti, Township Manager

Meeting began at 7:00 p.m.

DCNR Grant for Amphitheatre in the Kimberton Park Meadow, below the tennis courts, approved by Board of Supervisors for permanent structure. This will be for both Township use and Rental. Jerry brought up that electric will need to be added.

Bridge Update – Poured Footings complete and bridge will be delivered 3/11 week. It will be set with the crane in Mid-Late March & ready by 3/30 for the opening of the Fishing season.

Kim Suggested graduate students from Technical College High School (formerly Cat Pickering) be recruited to design benches for the trail.

Interpretive signage will be installed when paving is finished.

Sean has 2 Spring Cleanups of the trail March 6 & April 20 at 9am and Kimberton Park on April 20. Students to be recruited from St. Basil 6th Grade & Scouts.

Sean suggested an “adopt an acre” plan for the 1.3 mile section of the trail. Find 100 groups to adopt a section to help maintain the trail. Possible signage was discussed and trail blazing.

Board OK'd to acquire Woodbridge Open Space. Kim will follow through on recording property. Property needs to be surveyed & legal description on recorded Woodbridge plans added.

Easter Egg Hunt is March 23 with advertised Rain date of March 30.

Start is 10am. Bunny to arrive at 9am for pictures with the kids. Signage for age groups for kids to gather will be posted in designated areas. There will be Nut Free candy & prizes. Postcard handouts will be available to announce June 1st Kimberton Park Day, 15th Birthday party.

Meeting then combined with Kimberton Park Anniversary Celebration committee. Emy Miller led Park and Rec subcommittee discussion. Cathy Latshaw was guest.

Birthday party celebration will last from 12-3pm with Food – Hot Dogs & Burgers, Pretzels, Pizza, Ice Cream & Cup cakes. Activities will include Face Painting, Raffle Baskets, Clowns/Jugglers & a Magician.
