

**East Pikeland Township
Park & Recreation Board Meeting
March 15, 2012**

Meeting began at 7pm

Since there was not a quorum present, minutes were reviewed but not approved.

Discussion of French Creek Trail cleanup. 20 people showed up to help clear multiflora roses, poison ivy and other invasives. Significant progress was made.

Sean brought up that local Girl Scout troops want to do an Earth Day cleanup on April 15th. They proposed working on the same areas as the previous cleanup. It was suggested that they also work the other side of the covered bridge. Since there was no quorum to approve, it was suggested that approval be done via email. If approved, Sean would be the Park & Rec member representative. If approved, it was suggested that a notice go up on the EP website.

Discussion of signage for trail. It was suggested that the dog trashcan & bag dispensing receptacle was a priority at the trail head. A general sign was discussed with the following as appropriate rules:

- Trail is open from dawn to dusk
- Keep pets on leash and remove any pet waste
- No motor vehicles allowed – except emergency vehicles
- Respect the rights of adjacent property owners – Stay on trail
- Bicycles – Yield to pedestrians – Give warning when passing
- No littering, No smoking, No consumption of alcohol or other illicit substances
- No hunting or trapping, no firearms
- No loud music

Signage discussion tabled for a meeting with a quorum.

Easter Egg Hunt March 31st. Volunteers to arrive 8:30am to hide eggs, hunt starts at 10am. The Police Department will be available to start the hunt with a siren.
