



**East Pikeland Historical Commission/HARB Meeting Minutes
February 19, 2014**

The meeting commenced at 7:00 pm. The meeting agenda was presented to the Commission members and the following issues were addressed:

GENERAL

- **Minutes** - The minutes from the January 15th meeting were presented and approved.
- **Historical Resource Ordinance** – Bob Wise, the Township Historic Preservation Consultant, presented his list of questions/comments on the Ordinance. The Commission agreed to continue the review discussion at a special meeting on February 27th.
- **Graceanna Lewis Historical Marker** – Ms. Moser informed the Commission that in conjunction with March’s Women’s History month, the dedication of the Graceanna Lewis historical marker will be held on Saturday, March 29th.
- **Town Walking Tour** - The East Pikeland walking tour will be held on June 19th. It will be called *Bridging History in East Pikeland Township* and will include stops at the Kennedy Covered Bridge, Prizers Mill, East Pikeland Elementary School, Hiestand Farmstead, and Hares Hill Bridge.
- **Kimberton Homeopathy – 2185 Kimberton Road** – A revised layout for the Kimberton Homeopathy sign was presented to the Commission for review. The PVC sign will be 4’ (wide) by 2’ (high). The colors will be beige for the copy with a color icon logo against a maroon background. The proposed sign will be two-sided with no lighting. After review the Commission agreed to issue a Certificate of Appropriateness.
