



## East Pikeland Historical Commission Meeting Minutes February 21, 2018

The meeting commenced at 7:00 pm.  
The meeting agenda was presented to the members and the following issues were discussed:

### GENERAL

- The minutes from the January 17, 2018, meeting were presented and approved.
- **Snyder's Mill Construction Project**—Mr. Garrison reported no major news at this point, but that the overall contract has been authorized, and final pricing of various project aspects is being collected. Project work is expected to start in March and should take about six weeks.
- **East Pikeland Township Planning Meeting** - Mr. Garrison reviewed a number of 2018 project goals discussed at the township planning meeting he attended with Kehl Rothermel on January 27<sup>th</sup>, and suggested these goals become action items for the Commission, with various members tracking them. Among the goals and issues cited were:
  - *Completion of Snyder's Mill Construction:* Weather resistant signage/markers are needed for inside the mill.
  - *Preservation Plan for Gow Summer Kitchen on the Cutler Tract:* The East Pikeland Board of Supervisors needs to make a decision concerning stabilization/maintenance. If structure isn't cared for, it will need to be torn down, with perhaps something built on the footprint of the old house.
  - *Preservation Plan and Phase 2 Archaeology Plan for Continental Powder Works Site:* A large mound of fill dirt has been dumped in area where archaeological dig should proceed.
