Job Title: Environmental Advisory Council Board Member

Purpose: The EAC Board members (as appointed by the Board of Supervisors) serve on the East Pikeland Township Environmental Advisory Council. This volunteer committee is comprised of 7 Township residents who work to advise and educate the Township and Township residents about environmental issues and provide solutions. The EAC promotes the protection and conservation of natural resources, strives to improve the quality of the environment in the Township, and sponsors educational workshops and events.

The Length of Appointment: 3-year term

Key Responsibilities:

- Attend Environmental Advisory Council meetings and events
- Provide input into current and new projects
 - Willing to research new ideas and report back to committee/respond to emails
- Contribute to initiatives and projects being pursued by the committee
- Help plan and promote programs, events, & activities

Qualifications:

- Must be an East Pikeland Township Resident, 18 years or older
- Be dedicated, fulfill time commitment requirements
- Respond promptly to emails when required
- Be courteous and personable when dealing with the public
- Be proactive and self-directed, willing to take initiative
- Respect fellow volunteers & Township staff
