General

- **Meeting Minutes** - The October meeting minutes were reviewed and approved.
- **Snyder's Mill Signage** - Ms. Ruzicka presented the proposed copy for the Snyder's Mill and Kimberton Grange interpretive signs. Once comments are received and incorporated, the copy will be sent to the Township Manager for review.
- **Volunteer Recognition Dinner** - The East Pikeland Township Volunteer Appreciation dinner will be held on December 6th at 6:00pm. The list of members that will be attending will be forwarded to the township office.

New

- **1166 Rapps Dam Road** - The homeowners would like to re-roof their historic home. The sheathing has failed under part of the north facing roof, most likely because the shingles held water and the plywood may have been the fire treated type that was later found to be vulnerable to prolonged moisture exposure. They are proposing a replacement in kind for the shingles and minor repairs in wood to the flat board fascias and soffits. Although no permit is necessary because the homeowners are not replacing more than 25% of the underlayment, the members agreed the replacement was necessary and work on the roof should move forward.
