HARB members and the following issues were addressed:

NEW BUSINESS

- **Shannon Chamberlin/Ideas Bookstore - 2234 Kimberton Road** – The business owner came before the HARB with her plan to renovate the property into a bookstore. She would like to paint the building a light apricot with a teal trim. The new front door will be replaced with a new solid mahogany or Spanish cedar door with sidelights and a transom. The glass in the door will be double-paned with full-view tempered glass. A large display window will be installed to the right of the front door. Upon review the information presented the HARB asked the applicant to supply the dimensions of the new front door as well as samples wall and trim paint colors to the Zoning officer. Once the HARB members were able to review this, a Certificate of Appropriateness would be issued. The applicant was informed that a separate sign permit form needed to be filled and submitted to the HARB for review.
