The meeting agenda was presented to the members and the following issues were discussed:

### General

- **Meeting Minutes** - The April 20<sup>th</sup> meeting minutes were reviewed and approved.
- **2383 Kimberton Road** - Ms. Jommersbach reported that the property owner has notified Township Zoning that they are currently soliciting bids to stabilize the outbuilding located on the property.
- **1266 Hares Hill Road** - Since Mr. Friebe was unsuccessful in trying to contact the property owner and what their plans are for preserving the rapidly deteriorating home; Ms. Jommersbach said that she would ask the zoning officer to send a vacant structure and property maintenance letter that will hopefully prompt them to call her.
- **June 19<sup>th</sup> Meeting** - Due to the Chester County Historical Preservation Network (CCHPN) Volunteer Appreciation Dinner, the June 19<sup>th</sup> Historical Commission meeting has been canceled.

### New

- **2264 Kimberton Road/Shelly Cuny** - The homeowner came before the Commission to discuss installing a four foot high black aluminum rail fence that would partially go around the front, side, and back of her property. After discussion, the Commission voted to approve the application
- **Sons of the American Revolution** - Mr. Garrison and Township Manager, Kim Moretti met with Peter Adams, Board member of the Sons of the American Revolution to discuss the grant request of \$50,000 (to be paid out over a period of two years) to aid in the Continental Powderworks archeology and signage. Mr. Adams indicated he will bring this request at a future Board meeting.
