The meeting agenda was presented to the members and the following issues were addressed:

NEW

- **Dennis Ray/ 2233 Kimberton Road** – The property owner would like to renovate the circa 1930's barn located on their property. The following are items they would like to do:
 - Door - Fascia molding to the bottom of the door and will be painted a creamy white
 - Walls - To protect the interior from the weather, sheathing and new T1-11 will be installed. Once completed the walls be painted a creamy white.
 - The trim under the eaves, the corners, the stars, and horizontal trim along the top and bottom of the doors will be painted red
 - Floor - Install a concrete floor
 - Electric - Add two outlets on the first floor and install lights on the first and second floorAfter review and discussion, the HARB voted to approve the request.
- **Centennial Church /1330 Hares Hill Road** – Ms. Ray came before the HARB to discuss the church's desire to replace the current outside sign with a new larger one. The proposed sign will be 5'x8'. The sign frame will be carved and painted signfoam. The welded aluminum sign will contain white acrylic sign panels with changeable letter tracking. The accent lighting for the sign is still to be determined. Mr. Garrison recommended that the church create a to-scale demo sign and place it in the location of the proposed new sign for the HARB to review. After review and discussion, the HARB voted to approve the sign layout and design. The final approval will be pending onsite approval by the HARB.
