

**East Pikeland Township  
Board of Supervisors Meeting  
January 2, 2018**

A public meeting of the Board of Supervisors of East Pikeland Township was held on Tuesday, January 2, 2018 at the Township Building, 1158 Rapps Dam Road, Kimberton. Present were Chairman Ron Graham, Vice Chairman Rusty Strauss, Supervisor Ben Campbell and Township Manager Kim Moretti.

Mr. Graham called the meeting to order at 7:15 p.m. following the annual Reorganization Meeting.

**Minutes**

Mr. Strauss made a MOTION to approve the December 5, 2017 meeting minutes. Mr. Campbell seconded the motion and the minutes were unanimously approved.

**Department Reports**

Township Manager – Mrs. Moretti reported that during the month of December the Kimberton Park amphitheater electrical connection was made; plumbing work will be completed in the spring. Two Boy Scout projects are underway – one on French Creek Trail and the other to create a concession stand for the amphitheater at the park. The new intersection at Route 23 and Crossover Blvd became operational with the activation of the traffic signal.

Police Department – Sgt. Wilson provided statistics for 2017: Officers responded to a total of 2790 complaints during the year, including: 3 burglaries, 48 thefts, 3 motor vehicle thefts, 27 DUIs, 18 drug arrests, 12 criminal mischief arrests, and 179 accidents. 357 traffic citations were issued in 2017.

Zoning Officer's Report – Kisha Tyler's annual zoning report was posted for review.

**Old Business**

Mr. Campbell made a MOTION to approve **RESOLUTION 2018-01**, recognizing resident Marilyn Randolph for many years of volunteer service to East Pikeland Township. Mr. Strauss seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

Mr. Campbell made a MOTION to approve **RESOLUTION 2018-02**, adopting an amended Fee Schedule. Mr. Strauss seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

Mr. Campbell made a MOTION to accept the resignation of Bill LaPorte from the Environmental Advisory Council. Mr. Strauss seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

Mr. Campbell made a MOTION to approve the timeclock extension for the Miller Pond Subdivision, Preliminary Plan Application, until April 7, 2018. Mr. Strauss seconded and it passed unanimously.

Mr. Campbell made a MOTION to approve Escrow Release No. 2 for 400 Westside Land Development in the amount of \$1,103,994.36, as recommended by the township engineer. Mr. Strauss seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

### **New Business**

Mr. Strauss made a MOTION to table the appointment of an auditor to fill a vacancy on the board of Auditors until the February meeting. Mr. Campbell seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Mr. Strauss made a MOTION to appoint Bill LaPorte to serve as Township representative to the Valley Forge Sewer Authority Board, with term expiring December 31, 2020. Mr. Campbell seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Mr. Strauss made a MOTION to appoint Elizabeth Burns to fill a vacancy on the Environmental Advisory Council with term ending December 31, 2019. Mr. Campbell seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Mr. Strauss made a MOTION to appoint Samantha Uyeno to a three-year term on the Environmental Advisory Council with term ending December 31, 2020. Mr. Campbell seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Mr. Strauss made a MOTION to appoint Travis Uyeno to a three-year term on the Environmental Advisory Council with term ending December 31, 2020. Mr. Campbell seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Mr. Strauss made a MOTION to approve **RESOLUTION 2018-03**, accepting the Bryn Coed Minor Subdivision Plan, subject to compliance with the LTL Consultants review letter dated December 29, 2017. Mr. Campbell seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Dennis Ray asked whether farming would be an allowable use on the Bryn Coed property. Mr. Strauss responded that farming is allowed per the conservation easement agreement.
