

**East Pikeland Township
Board of Supervisors Meeting
December 3, 2019**

A public meeting of the Board of Supervisors of East Pikeland Township was held on December 3, 2019 at the Township Building, 1158 Rapps Dam Road, Phoenixville. Present were Chairman Ron Graham, Vice Chairman Rusty Strauss, Supervisor Ben Campbell and Township Manager Kim Moretti. Mr. Graham called the meeting to order at 7:00p.m.

Mr. Strauss made a MOTION to approve the November 12, 2019 meeting minutes. Mr. Campbell seconded the motion and the minutes were unanimously approved.
