A. Old Business

1. Amphitheater Update

Builders are currently waiting for the poured concrete foundation to cure before continuing construction. Once construction resumes it should only take about a week. The water line has been run from the amphitheater to the fountain near the tennis court, but has not yet been connected.

Kim is looking into having a boy scout to help build out the concession stand using the shed from the lot on Prizer Road.

2. Woodbridge Open Space Update

Paperwork for the easement is waiting to be signed by the property owners

3. French Creek Trail Update

a. Naming Opportunities – Sean volunteered to write an article about the trail progress and clean up to occur in April. He will also include naming opportunities for parts of the trail and possibly amphitheater.

- i. \$10,000 for metal bridge
- ii. \$2,500 for Boy Scout bridges
- iii. \$500 for a bench
- iv. \$25,000 for the amphitheater.

b. Mile Markers – The committee discussed adding mile markers and signage to the trail. The use of natural marker such as stone was also discussed.

c. Spring Clean Up – Spring cleanup for the trail is scheduled for April 22, 2017 which is Earth Day. Sean will discuss the cleanup in an article for the newsletter. Green Valley and EAC will be cleaning up around French Creek that day as well. It was thought that two teams would be best, one to work on the trail and the other to work on the parking lot on township line road.

4. Phoenixville Regional Multi-Modal Transportation Study

Representatives from the study will start meeting with area stakeholders to discuss needs and gather more information. Kim thought it would be good for them to meet with this committee. She will work with the group to schedule a visit to one of our future meetings.

B. New Business

1. Easter Egg Hunt – Saturday April 8, 2017 with a rain date of April 15, 2017
Volunteer duties will be discussed in more detail at the March meeting. The new lot on Prizer Rd will be used for overflow parking. Kim will have the township staff clear the brush and overgrowth from the lot. She will also reach out to the Cleanup Crew to see if they would be interested in stuffing the eggs again this year.

2. Volunteer Search for new member
Rick Bullotta has resigned from the committee. Kim asked that the committee members think of any possible volunteers for the opening. The members also discussed that some diversity on the committee would be appreciated.

3. Miscellaneous
Kim informed the committee and handed out informational pamphlets about the township being under a quarantine for the Spotted Lantern Fly which means that no wood/woodchips can leave the township. This arose around a conversation regarding the Asplundh debris at the Firehouse property that is used by KYAL.

There was brief discussion about an increase in the number of homeless individuals found along French Creek under and around the bridges near Redner's.
