Minutes from the June meeting were approved without changes.

**New Business**

1. Bike Maintenance Workshop

- Michelle reported that a resident reached out about community service hours. He listed bike maintenance as one of his skills. Michelle asked the Board if they would be interested in doing a bike maintenance workshop for residents. The Board was very interested and suggested August or early September as a time. Michelle will reach out.

**Old Business**

1. KYAL

- Michelle reported that the water meter was officially installed on July 10 so the Township can bill KYAL for their water usage.

2. Ridge Rd./Dog Park

- The meeting was held at 75 Ridge Rd. to discuss the potential uses and layout of a dog park. The committee discussed putting the dog park at the far end of the property, improving the trail, planting trees, and improving stormwater. You would need roughly 5 acres for the dog park in total, including parking. The Stevensons, the homeowners nearest the property, were in attendance to voice their concerns about the development of the lots impacting their property.

3. 2019 Events & Programs

- Summer Concert Series #2 – 7/18 Stay tuned for weather updates. Michelle will make a decision late in the afternoon about the status of the event. The Mighty Manatees could play at the Art & Music Festival if they aren't able to play on 7/18
- Children's Theater – this new event will take place on 8/3 from 11am-12pm. Committee members agreed to only sell drinks in the concession stand. Michelle will follow up with the play company to determine where volunteers might be needed, if at all.

  - Michelle reported that a headliner and more craft vendors are still needed, but that everything else is coming together.
